» Ongoing Projects



Construction of Janata School, Bharatpur

Shree Janata Higher Secondary School was established in 1957 as a community school and later was upgraded to a higher secondary school. The school is constructing a building to run computer classes with the help of School Management Committee and Village Development Committee.

HeNN will be providing USD 4225.35/- to the school in three installments. The first installment of USD 1,400 was handed to the school on 14 November 2010 at the HeNN Office in Kathmandu by Dr Upendra Mahato, patron of NRN Association.

Shree Jagadamba Higher Secondary School was established in 1973 as a primary school and was upgraded to lower secondary, secondary and higher secondary levels in 1983, 1989 and 2007 respectively.

Shree Janata Higher Secondary School

HeNN, after studying the project proposal has decided to provide USD 4,225.35/- to the school in three installments. The first installment was handed over on 14 Nov 2010 at the HeNN Office by Dr Upendra Mahato. Dr Mahato said he would contribute around USD 1,400 from his personal funds if the school demonstrated sincerity and commitment in its work.

Construction of Manakot School, Bajura

Shree Manakot Lower Secondary School was established in 2007 with the support of local social workers, intellectuals and the school management committee. Due to increasing number of students, the school lacks an adequate number of classrooms. The school approached HeNN to construct two additional rooms and to provide the furniture.



HeNN has decided to provide USD 6338.03/- in three installments. The first installment of USD 2112.68/- was handed to the school on 27 December 2010 at the HeNN office by the leading industrialist, Mr. Siddhartha Rana at the formal inauguration of Help Nepal Network office, Kathmandu.

Shree Manakot Lower Secondary School



Construction of Thokarpa School, Sindhupalchowk

Shree Thokarpa Secondary School was established in 1971 as a primary school. The school has upgraded to class 9 and has plans to run grade 10 from 2010-2011.

The school aims to construct two additional classrooms to accommodate grade 10 and an increasing number of students joining the school. The school approached HeNN for the financial support. HeNN has decided to provide USD 6338.03/- in three installments.



The first installment of USD 2112.68/- was handed over to the school on 27 December 2010 at the HeNN office.

Shree Thokarpa Secondary School



Construction of Mugu School, Morang

Shree Mugu Primary School was established in 1983 with the support of local parents and intellectuals. The school is in a dilapidated condition and needs to be renovated. The school approached Help Nepal Network for the financial support to construct the school building. HeNN has decided to provide USD 4225.36/- in three installments. The first installment of USD 1408.46/- was handed over to the school on 27th December 2010 at the HeNN office.



The funds for these schools were raised by members of "Run for Change" (www.runforchangenepal.com) who took part in the British 10 km marathon event. Cheques were handed over to school representatives by Mr. Siddhartha Rana during the inauguration of HeNN's Secretariat in Kathmandu on 27 December 2010 at the HeNN office.

Shree Mugu Primary School

Construction of Sarlahi health clinic, Sarlahi

The second installment of funds, USD 4225.36/- to construct a health clinic in Haripurwa, Sarlahi has been handed over to the representatives of the clinic. The progress report of the first phase has been submitted to HeNN office. The funds were largely used to purchase construction materials.



Saraswoti Higher Secondary School, Gulmi

HeNN provided the second installment of USD 2142.86 to Saraswoti Higher Secondary School, Gulmi after receiving the progress report of the first phase. The first phase involved leveling of the ground, completion of RCC, pillaring, and part roofing. The construction work is expected to be completed soon.

HELP NEPAL Balbalika Kendra (HELP NEPAL Children's Shelter) is a major project being undertaken by the HeNN. Upon completion it will house around 50 children. The Centre is currently under construction. A substantial amount of funding was provided by Swiss philanthropist, Dr. Franz Schmid.

Swiss Charity Donates USD 20,000

A Switzerland-based charity led by Dr Franz Schmid donated USD 20,000 to support the construction of HELP NEPAL Balbalika Kendra (Children's Centre) in Kavre. Dr. Schmid who is interested in helping Nepali children, visited the construction site of the centre in August 2010. During his visit to Nepal, Dr. Schmid committed to provide support to the centre in future.

HELP NEPAL Balbalika Kendra is a major project being undertaken by HeNN. Upon completion, it will house around 50 children. The funds provided by Dr. Schmid will be utilized for the construction of Centre- including channel gate, flooring and fittings in the toilet and kitchen, plastering the staircase and fitting tiles. Any left over funds will be used to furnish the Centre.
